## Rosemarie's Art Gallery & Craft Supplies

### INSTRUCTIONS:

Thank you for giving our kit a try. While this is not a "shake the box" type of kit, it is not difficult to build at all. Before you get started, we do recommend that you read the instructions and examine the parts to familiarize yourself with our construction methods. Let us first recommend some useful tools which will make the job of cutting and fitting easy:

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| 1 - Steel HO Scale ruler                 | 5 - Miter Box  |
| 2 - Hobby knife with <u>sharp</u> blades | 6 - A piece of plate glass as work surface (not plastic) |
| 3 - Fine tooth file                      | 7 - Liquid plastic cement                                |
| 4 - Razor saw                            |  |

To start this project, let's do all the brick walls starting with the rear wall, which is made up from the two halves as shown in the drawing below. (The drawing has been reduced by 30% of the full size to fit this page.) Lay the two halves face down and notice the molded-in cutting guides. Then make the rear wall for Rosemarie's building, cut the two pieces from the back halves using either a hobby knife or a razor saw - both work well, making sure to keep the cut perpendicular to the walls. Sand the cut edges smooth, and cement the two halves together as shown. A butt joint will be quite strong and suffice for this purpose. The freight door shown in the drawing should be added later.
